

BYELAWS

GENERAL MEETINGS

- 1. The annual general meeting of the club shall be held in every year at such of the club premises and on such a day as the committee shall appoint.
- Fourteen days notice of the meeting shall be given to every member of the club specifying the business to be transacted.
- If the committee has not called an annual general meeting by the 30th September in any year any 20 members may call the meeting for any date thereafter by 14 days notice signed by them.
- Special general meetings may be called at any time by the committee by giving 7 days notice to each member.
- No business other than the election of officers and members to serve on the committee shall be transacted at any general meeting unless at least 10 members are present.
- 6. Voting at general meetings shall be by show of hands or otherwise as the chairman may direct.
- 7. At all general meetings the chairman of the committee shall preside. If the chairman of the committee is not present within five minutes after the time appointed for holding the meeting the meeting shall chose its own chairman.
- ii. The secretary shall record in a minute book the proceedings of general meetings.

ELECTION OF COMMITEE

- 7. At the annual general meeting of the club not more than 20 ordinary mambers shall be elected to serve on the committee to hold office until the next annual general meeting.
- 10. Retiring members of the committee shall be eligible for re-election.
- 11. If a casual vacancy occurs by the death or resignation of a member of the committee or by such member ceasing for any reason to be a member of the club the vacancy shall be filled by co-option.
- 12. Candidates for election to the committee must be approved by the directors of the Company and proposed and seconded by members of the club.

ELECTION OF SECRETARY

- 13. A secretary shall be elected at the first and every subsequent annual general meeting of the club to hold office until the then next annual general meeting when he shall be eligible for re-election.
- 14. A casual vacancy occurring by death resignation or other cause during the year of office of the secretary shall be filled by the committee appointing one of their own number.

PROCEEDINGS OF COMMITTEE

- 15. The committee shall chose its own chairman and regulate its own procedure.
- 16. Meetings of the committee shall be called by the secretary at least four times a year. Additional meetings may be called by the secretary and shall be called by him if requested by the chairman or any Z members of the committee.
- IT. Three members shall be a quorum.
- 18. Every member of the committee shall have are vote on every question and in case of equality the chairman or other member presiding at the meaning shall have a second or casting vote.
- 19. The secretary shall keep minutes of the proceedings of each meeting.
- The committee may appoint sub committees and depute to them any of its powers.

CONDUCT OF MEMBERS

- 21. The bringing into club premises or consumption or circulation there-in of intoxicating liquor or prohibited drugs by members is forbidden and the committee or any member there-of shall expel from the club any member contravening this byelaw.
- 22. Any member who shall be or appear to be in an intoxicated condition or subject to the influence of drugs (save such as may have been properly prescribed to him) shall be refused admission to club premises.
- Illegal gaming on the club premises is prohibited and any member found participating in Illegal gaming shall be liable to expulsion from the club.
- 24. Any member using abusive or offensive language on club premises or outside club premises abusing any other member of the club shall be liable to expulsion from the club.
- 25. Any member who in club premises threatens offers or uses violence to any other member or to any artist shall be liable to expulsion from the club.
- Z6. Any member who shall be convicted on indictment of any offence (save offence under the Road Traffic Acts) may be expelled from the club.

ADMISSION TO FUNCTIONS

27. A charge may be made for admission of members and their gueats to function of the club. The sum payable shall be determined by the committee (after consultation with the directors of the Company) from time to time.



- The name of the club is "U.F.O. CLUB".
- The club is formed for the social intercourse of persons interested in new and experimental developments in the arts and to afford to members facilities for meeting one another and entertaining their friends.
- Persons over the age of eighteen who are in general sympathy with the aims and objects of the club are qualified for membership.
- 4. The club is a proprietary club, the proprietors and sole managers of which are (subject to these rules) the UFO Club Limited (hereinafter called the Company)
- The Company shall provide the club with premises in the West End of London 5. The Company shall provide the cits with premises in the west and of London and artists and all other facilities necessary for carrying on the ciub in accordance with its objects and these rules and will be solely responsible for all expenses connected there-with and for the engagement and payment of artists entertainers and all other employees and for catering and all other matters involving expenditure
- 6. Every member of the club shall subject to these rules and the byelaws for the time being in force be exitted to use and enjoy in common with the other members of the club the premises and the furniture fittings and other things there-in provided by the Company for the use of the club but shall not by reason of his membership be under any financial liability except for payment of his annual subscription.
- 7. The club shall remains of such jumbers of ordinary members (including life-members elected in accordance with hale a and honorary members elected in accordance with Rule 9) as the general committee (hereinafter in these rules and byelaws called "the Committee") shall from time to time pasts discretion decide.
- On the recommendation of the Committee ardinary members may in special circumstances be elected lie members at any general meeting of the club or by the committee exercising powers delegated to it by a general meeting of the club and shall thereafter be entitled to all the privileges of membership without paying the yearly subscription or any special payment for such life membership.
- On the recommendation of the committee honorary members may be elected at any general meeting of the club or by the committee exercising powers delegated to the elemental meeting of the club. Honorary members shall be estitled to all the privileges of membership except that they shall not be entitled to vote at meetings.
- 10. The committee shall have power to admit to the club such visitors as they shall decide who shall upon payment of such some (if any) as may be demanded of them by the committee and upon signing a book kept by the committee for such purpose and undertaking to shide by the rules and byslaws of the club in so far as applicable be permitted to enjoy the facilities of the club for such limited period as the commit shall appoint and such visitors shall be deemed to be honorary members.
- 11. Each member of the club shall be permitted to bring with him to functions of the club not more than three guests who shall sign the guest book and undertake to ahide by the rules and byelswe of the club and shall pay such sum as shall be determined by the committee from three to time. A guest shall be present on club premises at the will of the committee and may be expelled there-from for any conduct ald contravene the rules or byclaws
- 12. The entrance (ee payable by a member on election shall be such sum as the committee shall from time to time determine. The committee may demand entrance fees of varying amounts and may remit the whole or part of the entrance
- 1). The annual subscriptions for ordinary members shall be such sum as the committee a all from time to time determine. A member elected after the first day account in any year shall only be required to pay half the subscription for
- 14. A member abroad for the whole of any year or for any period exceeding three months in any year shall pay a nominal subscription for that year, such subscription to the tear such subscription to the secretary to be determined by the committee, provided he shall have given to the secretary previous notice in writing of his intention to be absent. If a member who has given notice under this rule shall return from abroad temperarily the company may adm it such member to all the privileges of membership for such period as it thinks fit be payment of a proportionate part of his full annual premium.

- 15. Annual subscriptions shall be due and payable on the first day of James each year and shall on or before that day be paid to the secretary on behalf of the company or to the account of the company at its bankers for the time being.
- 16. Every candidate for membership shall be proposed by an excisting mamber who shall be responsible for his or her eligibility. The application for men learning for every such candidate shall be made in writing signed by the cardidate shall be in such form as the committee may from time to
- 17. Ordinary members shall be elected either at a general meeting or by the committee. Upon election there becomes due from the member the entrance for and the first annual subscription.
- 18. A member desiring to withdraw from the club must give notice in writing to the secretary.
- 19. If any member's subscription is in arrear the secretary shall send him notice with a request for immediate payment and if his subscription is not paid within fourteen days the committee shall remove his name from the register of members and he shall thereupon cease to be a member and forfeit all rights of membership. Provided that the committee may at any time in their discretion restore him him to membership upon payment of all arrears of subscription then due.
- The committee may expel from the club any members whose conduct is such as in their opinion be injurious to the character of the club or the interests of the members. A member expelled shall forfeit all the privileges of membership and all rights against the club.
- 21. An annual general meeting of the club shall be held once in every year for the election of members to serve on the committee and of afficers of the club for such other business as may be appointed in accordance with the rules and
- 22. At all general meetings of the club every member of the club shall be entitled to be present and (except as provided in Rule 9) to give one vote and no more upon every question provided that in case of equality of votes the chairman of the meeting shall have a second or caeting vote.
- 23. The committee shall exercise the powers given to it by these rules and such other powers of management as the affairs of the club may from time to time require. The committee shall consist of not more than 20 members elected by the ordinary members of the club in general meeting in accordance with the byelaws.
- 24. The club may from time to time in accordance with the byelaws for the time being in force elect a secretary and other officers,
- 25. The secretary of the company if he is a member of the club may be elected secretary of the club.
- 26. All expenses of the officers and committee reasonably incurred on behalf of the club for fares, stationery, printing, postages, catering and all other things will be paid by the Company.
- 7. The committee may from time to time make vary and revoke byelaws not aconsistent with the rules for the regulation of the internal affairs of the club and conduct of members. All byelaws shall, until revoked by the committee, be nding on the members.
- Any dispute or difference which may arise as to the meaning or interpretation these rules or the byelaws or as to the powers of the officers or committee or validity of any election or proceeding of the committee shall be determined by board of directors of the Company whose decision shall be final and binding
- 37 These rules or any of them may from time to time be revoked altered or d to by a resolution passed at a general meeting of the members of the club majority of the members present being members entitled to vote.
- 30. All notices required by these rules and by the byelaws to be given to members of the club may be given either by prepaid letter addressed to a member at the last address which he has furnished to the secretary or may be posted on the club notice board at the club premises.
- 31. The following modifications of the rules shall have effect until the club is

- Until a general committee is elected in accordance with Rule 20 the board of directors of the Company shall appoint a committee who shall exercise the powers given to the rules by the general committee.
